FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How much do I pay for my prescriptions?

RETAIL PHARMACY (UP TO 30 DAYS SUPPLY)	
Generic	\$10.00
Brand	\$30.00
Brand with Generic	\$30.00 + Difference in Cost
SAV-RX MAIL ORDER (UP TO 90 DAYS SUPPLY)	
Generic	\$20.00
Brand	\$60.00
Brand with Generic	\$60.00 + Difference in Cost

Note: Your plan has an annual maximum out of pocket of \$2,000 for individuals and \$4,000 for families.

Note: Certain classes of drugs may be covered at 100% in compliance with Affordable Care Act guidelines.

2. When do I use the mail service?

Your Plan includes a Mandatory Mail Order Program. The Sav-Rx Mail Order Pharmacy should be used for all maintenance medications. You may receive your first three fills at a participating retail pharmacy. Your fourth and subsequent refills for all maintenance medications are required to be filled at the Sav-Rx Mail Order Pharmacy. Refill orders may be placed by phone at 1-866-91-BRICK (27425), or www.savrx.com. Using the mail order is easy, convenient and will save you money.

3. How do I get the best value in my pharmacy benefit?

The best way to ensure that you are getting the best value in your pharmacy benefits is to use generics whenever they are available. If you purchase a brand name product that has an equivalent generic available, you will be responsible for paying the difference in cost between the brand and the generic equivalent.

Many brand name drugs do not have a generic equivalent but a generic drug is available within the same therapeutic class and is designed to treat the same condition. It is recommended that whenever you visit with your physician, you discuss the importance of using generics whenever they are available because it will save you money at the pharmacy.

4. Are generics just as safe and effective as brand name medications?

Generic drugs have been approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) as safe and effective. Generic drugs contain the same active ingredients in the same amounts as the brand name product. The generic version works like the brand name drug in dosage, strength, performance and use. Generics may differ in color, shape, size or flavor from the brand product; however, these differences do not effect the performance, safety or effectiveness of the generic drug.

5. What medications are covered?

Most maintenance medications are covered by your plan. These include, but are not limited to: legend drugs, insulin, contraceptives and more. Please refer to your Summary Plan Description for specific coverage rules.

Certain classes are excluded from coverage such as: over the counter medications, weight loss, fertility, devices/appliances, cosmetic, and drugs used for experimental purposes.

Some medications may require prior approval such as injectables, growth hormones and specialty medications. Some medications may be subject to quantity limits and/or step therapy.
