IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR HOSPITAL NETWORK – VHS FACILITIES MAY BE NON-CONTRACTED EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026

Dear Participant,

Our hospital contracts are negotiated and managed by the Health Services Coalition (HSC). HSC works diligently to re-negotiate our hospital contracts every three years to ensure the best quality at the most affordable rates. In the past, we have been very fortunate to have contracted hospitals who share our values of providing the best quality of care at reasonable pricing. Unfortunately, at this time the Valley Health System (VHS) has refused to negotiate acceptable rates.

Effective January 1, 2026, the following facilities may no longer be in-network, and therefore will not be listed in enrollment materials this fall:

- ✓ Valley Hospital
- ✓ Centennial Hills Hospital
- ✓ Summerlin Hospital
- ✓ Spring Valley Hospital
- ✓ Henderson Hospital
- ✓ West Henderson Hospital
- ✓ Valley Health Specialty Hospital
- ✓ Free Standing Emergency Rooms
 - Elite Medical, ER at Blue Diamond, ER at Cadence, ER at Desert Springs, ER at Green Valley Ranch, ER at North Las Vegas, ER at Summerlin South, ER at Valley Vista, ER at West Craig.

Care provided at one of the above facilities after December 31, 2025 could mean much higher out-of-pocket costs to you.

ELECTIVE SERVICES/SURGERY – If you are currently receiving services at one of the VHS facilities listed above or are planning to have services or surgery at one of the facilities listed above after December 31, 2025, please work with your physician to schedule your services/surgery at a contracted facility. Please do not wait until the last minute to talk with your doctor. If you choose to have care at one of the facilities above after December 31, 2025, you could face substantially higher out-of-pocket costs.

OB DELIVERY – If you are planning on delivering a baby after December 31, 2025, at one of the VHS facilities listed above, please talk with your physician immediately about scheduling your delivery at a contracted hospital.

EMERGENCY SERVICES – You should always go to the hospital emergency room that can provide the best possible care to you, however, if your emergency is not life-threatening and you can safely be transported to a contracted hospital, you will have significantly less out-of-pocket costs. If you are admitted to a VHS facility after December 31, 2025, we will work with your physician to transfer you to a contracted hospital once you are in stable condition.

ADMITTED PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, 2026 – If you are admitted to one of the VHS hospitals prior to midnight December 31, 2025, and remain there after January 1, 2026, your claim will be processed at the in-network benefit.

We deeply regret any stress this may cause you and your family. We want to be up front with you about any possibility of a network change now so you can plan accordingly. Please know, the decision to notify you was taken very seriously and the Health Services Coalition has tried to avoid it, however, we have a responsibility to you to ensure the best quality of care at affordable pricing. Unfortunately, the Valley Health System has been unwilling to compromise on its rates. We do, however, hope to continue to negotiate in good faith.

The good news is that all of the other hospitals in the Las Vegas valley remain contracted.

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INFORMACIÓN IMPORTANTE SOBRE SU RED HOSPITALARIA: LAS INSTALACIONES DE VHS PODRÍAN NO TENER CONTRATO A PARTIR DEL 1 DE ENERO DE 2026

Estimado/a participante,

Nuestros contratos hospitalarios son negociados y administrados por la Coalición de Servicios de Salud (HSC). HSC trabaja diligentemente para renegociar nuestros contratos hospitalarios cada tres años para garantizar la mejor calidad a precios accesibles. Anteriormente, hemos tenido la gran suerte de contar con hospitales contratados que comparten nuestros valores de brindar la mejor calidad de atención a precios razonables. Lamentablemente, actualmente, Valley Health System (VHS) se ha negado a negociar tarifas aceptables.

A partir del 1 de enero de 2026, es posible que los siguientes centros ya no estén dentro de la red y, por lo tanto, no aparecerán en los materiales de inscripción este otoño:

 - Elite Medical, sala de emergencias en Blue Diamond, sala de emergencias en Cadence, sala de emergencias en Desert Springs, sala de emergencias en Green Valley Ranch, sala de emergencias en North Las Vegas, sala de emergencias en Summerlin South, sala de emergencias en Valley Vista, sala de emergencias en West Craig.

La atención brindada en una de las instalaciones mencionadas anteriormente después del 31 de diciembre de 2025 podría significar costos de bolsillo mucho más altos para usted.

SERVICIOS ELECTIVOS/CIRUGÍA– Si actualmente recibe servicios en uno de los centros de VHS mencionados anteriormente o planea recibir servicios o cirugía en uno de ellos después del 31 de diciembre de 2025, consulte con su médico para programar su servicio o cirugía en un centro contratado. Por favor no espere hasta el último momento para hablar con su médico. Si decide recibir atención en uno de los centros mencionados después del 31 de diciembre de 2025, podría tener que afrontar gastos de bolsillo considerablemente mayores.

PARTO OB – Si planea dar a luz a un bebé después del 31 de diciembre de 2025 en uno de los centros de VHS enumerados anteriormente, hable con su médico de inmediato sobre cómo programar su parto en un hospital contratado.

SERVICIOS DE EMERGENCIA – Siempre debe acudir a la sala de urgencias del hospital que le brinde la mejor atención posible. Sin embargo, si su emergencia no pone en peligro su vida y puede ser trasladado de forma segura a un hospital concertado, tendrá gastos de bolsillo significativamente menores. Si ingresa en un centro de VHS después del 31 de diciembre de 2025, colaboraremos con su médico para trasladarlo a un hospital concertado una vez que se encuentre en condición estable.

ADMITIDO ANTES DEL 1 DE ENERO DE 2026 – Si lo admiten en uno de los hospitales VHS antes de la medianoche del 31 de diciembre de 2025 y permanece allí después del 1 de enero de 2026, su reclamo se procesará según el beneficio dentro de la red.

Lamentamos profundamente cualquier estrés que esto pueda causarles a usted y a su familia. Queremos informarles con franqueza sobre cualquier posible cambio de red para que puedan planificar adecuadamente. Tengan en cuenta que la decisión de notificarles se tomó muy en serio y la Coalición de Servicios de Salud ha intentado evitarlo. Sin embargo, tenemos la responsabilidad ante ustedes de garantizar la mejor calidad de atención a precios asequibles. Lamentablemente, Valley Health System no ha estado dispuesto a ceder en sus tarifas. No obstante, esperamos seguir negociando de buena fe.

La buena noticia es que todos los demás hospitales del valle de Las Vegas siguen contratados.
