Delta Dental PPO dentists have agreed to charge \$850 for the \$1,310 service, a savings of \$460. Your Delta Dental plan covers 50 percent of the cost. Assuming you've already met your deductible for the year, Delta Dental will pay \$425 and you'll pay \$425.	Delta Dental Premier dentists have agreed to charge \$1,025—a savings of \$285 compared to the fee the dentist usually charges. Delta Dental will not cover the \$850 PPO fee, paying \$0. The dentist can bill you the difference between the PPO fee and the maximum allowed fee, making your bill \$1,025. That's an extra \$600 you will owe when compared to what you would have paid with a Delta Dental PPO dentist.	Nonparticipating dentists have not agreed to charge lower fees and can bill the full \$1,310. Delta Dental will pay based on the \$850 PPO fee, which means Delta Dental's share of the tab is \$0. The dentist can bill you the difference between Delta Dental's payment and what they charge. This leaves you with a bill of \$1,310, which includes the \$385 the nonparticipating dentist can "balance bill."
