SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

LOCAL UNION NO 306 IBEW PENSION ANNUITY PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report for the Local Union No 306 IBEW Pension Annuity Plan, (EIN: 34-6689590 PN: 001) for the year ended December 31, 2025. The annual report has been filed with the Internal Revenue Service, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Benefits under the plan are provided through insurance and/or annuity contracts and by a Trust Fund. Plan expenses were \$18,394,064, which included \$579,491 in administrative expenses and \$17,814,573 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 1,409 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$334,869,639 as of December 31, 2025, compared to \$302,135,896 as of December 31, 2024. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase (decrease) in its net assets of \$32,733,743. This increase (decrease) includes unrealized appreciation/ (depreciation) in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income (loss) of \$51,127,807 including employer contributions of \$12,354,090, income from investments of \$9,180,917, other income of \$402,881, and net gains (losses) from investments of \$29,189,919.

YOUR RIGHTS TO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, upon request. Included in that report is an accountant's report, schedule of assets held for investment, and actuarial information regarding the funding of the plan.

You also have the right to receive from the plan administrator, on request and at no charge, a statement of the assets and liabilities of the plan and accompanying notes, or a statement of income and expenses of the plan and accompanying notes, or both. If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of the report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for copying these portions of the report, which are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan, 3660 Stutz Drive, Suite 101, Canfield, Ohio 44406, and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor on payment of copying costs.
