WOMEN'S HEALTH AND CANCER RIGHTS ACT OF 1988

As required by the Women's Health and Cancer Rights Act of 1988, this Plan provides benefits for mastectomy-related services which include reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed, surgery on the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance and prostheses and treatment of physical complications of all stages of mastectomy, including lymphedemas. This coverage is subject to the Plan's annual deductibles and co-insurance provisions and was effective January 1, 1999.

NEWBORNS' AND MOTHERS' HEALTH PROTECTION ACT OF 1996

The Newborns' and Mothers' Health Protection Act of 1996 (Newborns' Act) requires group health plans that offer maternity hospital benefits for mothers and newborns to pay for at least a 48-hour hospital stay for the mother and newborn following childbirth (or, in the case of cesarean section a 96-hour hospital stay), unless the attending provider, in consultation with the mother, decides to discharge earlier.
