NOTE 1 DESCRIPTION OF PLAN

The following description of Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific National Health Benefit Trust Retiree Health Reimbursement Arrangement (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

General

The Plan is maintained pursuant to the terms of collective bargaining agreements between participating employers and the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific, Marine Division of I.L.W.U., and other employers who have signed joinder agreements with the Plan, all of whom have been accepted by the Board of Trustees. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

The Plan was established January 1, 2016 as a spin off from the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific National Health Benefit Plan to establish a separate plan for health reimbursement accounts (HRA) for Medicare Eligible retirees and their Medicare eligible dependents..

Contributions

The Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific National Health Benefit Plan provides that participating employers make monthly or bi-monthly contributions at a rate of \$25 per active participant during 2018 (\$20 per active participant during 2017) to provide health reimbursement arrangement benefits to eligible participants. The Board of Trustees has sole discretion to determine the amount of funds to be allocated to the HRA each Plan year. There are no participant contributions allowed.

The Board of Trustees approved allocating \$1,272 and \$1,116 to each HRA account for 2018 and 2017, respectively, prorated for participants who became eligible during the year.

Benefits

The HRA allows eligible participants to be reimbursed tax free for qualified medical expenses. Amounts remaining at the end of the year can generally be carried over to the next year. Unused balances are not refunded and are not portable upon termination.

Participant Accounts

Each participant's account is credited with the amount allocated to their accounts by the Board of Trustees. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided by the participant's account.

NOTE 2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires the Plan's Board of Trustees to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Payment of Benefits

Claims are recorded when paid.

Subsequent Events

The Plan has evaluated subsequent events through October 8, 2019, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

NOTE 3 TAX STATUS

The Trust established under the Plan to hold the Plan's assets is qualified pursuant to Section 501(c)(9) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) and, accordingly, the Trust's net investment income is exempt from income taxes. The Plan has obtained a favorable tax determination letter from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and the Plan's Board of Trustees believes that the Plan, as amended, continues to qualify and to operate as designed.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require the Plan's Board of Trustees to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability (or asset) if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

NOTE 4 EXTEND HEALTH CLAIMS PREFUND

The Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific National Health Benefit Plan was required to deposit \$28,000 with Extend Health at the commencement of their contract in 2012. This amount was held in deposit with Extend Health to pre-fund HRA claims processed by Extend Health. The available balance of this prefunding was \$24,648 and \$27,275 at December 31, 2018 and 2017, respectively.

NOTE 5 PLAN TERMINATION

Although it has not expressed any intention to do so, the Board of Trustees has the right under the Plan to terminate the Trust.

In any event, the Trust shall be automatically terminated upon the expiration of all collective bargaining agreements requiring the payment of contributions to the Plan; provided, however, that such termination shall not result from the expiration of all collective bargaining agreements so long as any employer continues to have a legal obligation to continue to make contributions to the Plan, or continues during contract negotiations to voluntarily contribute to the Plan without the union's objection, and provided the Plan is permitted by law to receive such contributions.

Upon the termination of the Trust, the Board of Trustees shall wind up the affairs of the Trust and Plan. In the event of any termination, any and all monies and assets remaining in the Trust, after the payment of expenses, shall be used for the payment of benefits in accordance with the purposes of the Plan, until such monies and assets have been exhausted, unless some other disposition is required by law.

In no event shall any of the remaining monies or assets be paid to or be recoverable by any participating employer, employer association, or labor organization.

NOTE 6 PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS

The Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific National Health Benefit Plan was established under the same Trust as the Plan. As mentioned in Note 1, the Plan spun off from the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific National Health Benefit Plan January 1, 2016. The Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific National Health Benefit Plan held \$-0- and \$319,650 of Plan assets at December 31, 2018 and 2017, respectively. During the 2018 Plan year, the Plan opened its own bank account and accounted for it in their 2018 Plan records. This eliminated the assets held by the Health Plan for the Plan at December 31, 2018.

The Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific National Health Benefit Plan pays expenses related to Plan operations to various service providers. The amount paid is reduced from the assets held in the related plan. These transactions are party-in-interest transactions under ERISA.
