The Board of Trustees has confirmed the following clarification to the Employee Painters' Trust (the "Plan") Plan Document and Summary Plan Description.

Preventive Care

This Summary of Material Modification is to modify coverage for Ambulance and Emergency Room services provided by non-PPO Providers. Out-of-Network services will have the same deductible as In-Network providers, in accordance with recent changes by the federal government.

Ambulance Covers medically necessary transport. Ground and Air Ambulance for member convenience or for non-clinical reasons is <u>not</u> covered. <i>Note: PPO - emergency use of a non-preferred provider will be covered at the preferred level subject to Prevailing Fee Reduction (by admin unless otherwise noted)</i>	70% AFTER DEDUCTIBLE	70% AFTER DEDUCTIBLE	70% AFTER DEDUCTIBLE	70% AFTER DEDUCTIBLE
Emergency Room - Health Care Reform requires out-of-network to be paid at in-network cost share Note: any copay applies only to E.R.
