Indiana Carpenters' Pension Fund Work After Retirement

Dear Participant:

For Calendar Year 2019 only, The Board of Trustees of the Indiana Carpenters' Pension Fund is pleased to announce the following change to the suspension of benefit rules:

Suspension of Benefits

Benefits generally are suspended for each month that a retiree works "at least 40 hours per month at the trade." *For Calendar Year 2019 only*, a retiree can work 600 hours at the trade. After 600 hours, a retiree's benefits will be suspended for working at least 40 hours or more per month at the trade."

Resumption (or Commencement) of Payments

For participants who were already receiving monthly pension payments at the time of initial benefit suspension, monthly pension payments will resume with the month following the month in which "Disqualifying Employment" terminates, subject to recovery of benefit overpayments. To resume monthly payments, a participant must contact the Fund Office.

This change to the suspension of benefits rule is only in effect for members who retired prior to January 1, 2019. This only applies to those retired participants who have retired prior to 12/31/18.
