SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR

FURNITURE AND INDUSTRIAL CARPENTERS HEALTH PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Furniture and Industrial Carpenters Health Plan, EIN 94-2621654 for the year ended May 31, 2015. The annual report has been filed with the Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Kaiser Foundation Health Plan, Inc., United Healthcare of California, Delta Dental of California, Safeguard Health Plans, Inc., A California Corporation, Vision Service Plan and The Prudential Insurance Company of America to pay certain medical, dental, vision, life, and accidental death and dismemberment benefits incurred under the terms of the plan. Premiums paid for the plan year ending May 31, 2015, totaled \$3,272,934.

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$824,627 as of May 31, 2015, compared to \$962,616 as of June 1, 2014. During the plan year, the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$137,989. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$3,236,940, including employer contributions of \$3,224,210, participant contributions of \$12,655, and earnings from investments of \$75.

Plan expenses were \$3,374,929. These expenses included \$139,549 in administrative expenses and \$3,235,380 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan at 1731 Technology Drive, San Jose, California 95110, and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, DC, or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
