RESTATED EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2014

AMENDMENT NO. 8

The Board of Trustees hereby amends the Iron Workers St. Louis District Council Pension Plan (the "Plan") adopted as of November 1, 2014 pursuant to the authority granted in Trust Article II and Plan Article 10, by amending the Plan effective April 25, 2018 as follows:

Section 3.12 is revised and amended to read as follows:


Section 3.12 Non-duplication of Pensions

A person shall be entitled to only one pension under this Plan with the following exceptions.

- a. A Pensioner may also receive a pension as the Spouse of a deceased Pensioner.
- b. A Pensioner who earns additional accrual and makes a new benefit election pursuant to Section 3.10(d).
- c. An Occupational Disability Pensioner, who recovers and earns additional accrual, may apply for a different type of pension, if he is otherwise eligible under the terms of the Plan.
- d. A Disability Pensioner who is no longer entitled to Social Security disability benefits and thus no longer Disabled, may apply for a different type of pension, if he is otherwise eligible under the terms of the Plan.
- e. A person who qualifies for an Occupational Disability Pension may thereafter convert to a Disability Pension upon providing the Fund Office with the Social Security Disability Award letter supporting the same medical condition. Upon conversion and consistent with Plan Section 3.17, the Disability Pension will be payable commencing with the first day of the third month following the month that Social Security determines the participant is disabled.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the above amendment to the Iron Workers St. Louis District Council Pension Plan was adopted by a motion passed by the Board of Trustees on July 25, 2018 that authorized the Chairman and Co-Chairman to sign this amendment on behalf of the Board of Trustees.
