


AMENDMENT NO. 8

SUMMARY PLAN DESCRIPTION AND PLAN DOCUMENT
(Effective January 1, 2023)


This is to certify that the Board of Trustees of the Operating Engineers Local 501 Security Fund or "Fund", have adopted the following Amendment to the Summary Plan Description and Plan Document. Specifically, the Fund has amended the Indemnity Medical Plan to increase the maximum air ambulance benefit from \$15,000 to \$100,000 retroactive to January 1, 2026. Accordingly, the following change is being made:

Effective January 1, 2026, in the section entitled Indemnity Medical Plan beginning on page 36, Summary of Active and Retiree Indemnity Medical Benefits and Covered Expenses, under the category Ambulance Services, the revision to the maximum air ambulance benefit is as follows:

Ground	\$50 copayment per trip, then 100% (of the contract rate) after annual deductible, up to a maximum benefit of \$5,000 per disability	\$50 copayment per trip, then 100% (of billed charges) after annual deductible, up to a maximum benefit of \$5,000 per disability
Air	\$50 copayment per trip, then 100% (of the contract rate) after annual deductible, up to a maximum benefit of \$15,000 \$100,000 per disability	\$50 copayment per trip, then 100% (of UCR) after annual deductible, up to a maximum benefit of \$15,000 \$100,000 per disability
