Dear Active and Early Pre-Medicare Retiree Participants:


Recently, The Board of Trustees of the Pipefitters Local 636 Insurance and Retiree Insurance Funds sent out communication about a partnership with Marathon Health. Beginning April 8, 2026, you and your eligible family members will have access to primary care and mental health services with Marathon Health.

As a reminder, Participants, spouses, and dependents (ages 2+) eligible under the Pipefitters Local 636 Insurance and Retiree Insurance Plans are eligible to use these Marathon Health clinics¹. This includes Opt-Out Participants. Unfortunately, at this time, Participants enrolled in the Fund's Medicare Advantage program are unable to utilize Marathon Health.

Services are no cost - \$0! Additionally, every participant (and their spouse) will receive \$150 if their annual physical exam is performed at Marathon.
