



## Introducing Delta Dental effective 6/1/2023

Effective June 1, 2023, Delta Dental will be the dental provider for the Trust. This means that Delta Dental will be paying the dental claims on behalf of the Trust and will be providing dental networks and customer service. If you have detailed questions about your dental claims for visits that occur on June 1, 2023 or later, please contact Delta Dental for assistance. Benesys will no longer have as much information on hand regarding the processing of dental claims. This change allows the Plan to improve the dental benefits without increasing costs.

### What's Changing

As part of this change, there will be a few enhancements to the plan:

- Deductible is waived for preventive services
- Preventive care is paid at 100% and does not apply to the annual maximum
- Orthodontia coverage is provided for both adults and children

You and your family have the choice to visit any dentist. Delta Dental maintains a network of dentists who have agreed to bill Delta Dental directly and accept a negotiated fee (discount). Allowable charges for out-of-network dentists are paid based on what 90% of the dentists in the area would consider reasonable. If your dentist is outside the Delta Dental network you may be responsible for any additional amounts above the reasonable fee (also called balance billing).
