### IMPORTANT NOTICE OF PRESCRIPTION BENEFIT MANAGER CHANGE

After careful review, the Board of Trustees is pleased to announce the following changes **effective June 1, 2022**.

The Fund's prescription benefit manager will change from Elixir (formerly EnvisionRx) to Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan (BCBSM). This change will replace the prescription coverage you currently have with Elixir. Your medical coverage is currently provided through an arrangement with BCBSM. With this change, your medical and prescription drug coverage will be integrated with BCBSM, which will make it easier for you and your family.

You will receive new ID cards from BCBSM prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>. The new ID cards you receive from BCBSM should be used for both medical and prescription drug services. The new card will replace the current cards you are using for medical and prescription drug coverage, so the old ones should no longer be used as of June 1<sup>st</sup>. You will also receive new dental and vision ID cards that will no longer include references to prescription drug coverage.

The prescription drug co-pays under the BCBS Rx plan will remain the same, as indicated below.

Drug Type	Network Retail – 30-day Supply	Network Retail – 90-day Supply
Generic	\$10 copay	\$20 copay
Preferred	\$30 copay	\$60 copay
Non-Preferred	\$60 copay	\$120 copay

Please note that it is possible that your prescription copays would be adjusted to a higher or lower tier based on the BCBSM formulary. Please visit [www.bcbsm.com/pharmacy](http://www.bcbsm.com/pharmacy) to review the list of covered drugs. If you are currently prescribed a medication that is not on the covered drug list, you will be allowed to continue using that drug at the regular co-pay.

BCBS Rx has a vast network of participating pharmacies, so you should be able to continue to use your current pharmacist. For a list of participating pharmacies, visit [www.bcbsm.com/pharmacy](http://www.bcbsm.com/pharmacy).
