POST-RETIREMENT DESIGNATION OF BENEFICIARY

I hereby elect the following post-retirement death beneficiary. If you are unmarried, you may designate anyone as your beneficiary. If you are married, you may name a beneficiary other than your spouse only with your spouse's consent.

Note on Default Beneficiaries: If you die without a valid beneficiary designation in effect, your benefits will be distributed to your spouse, if any; or if none, to your children; or if none, to your father and/or mother; or if not living, to your sisters and/or brothers; or if none, to your estate. Your divorce automatically revokes your prior designation of your former spouse. However, any other beneficiary designation you made in the past remains valid unless you revoke it.

Note: A Single Life Annuity is a monthly benefit for your life alone, with a guarantee of a minimum number of benefit payments. That minimum number is the number of months that it takes to equal the total contributions that were made on your behalf, or if you were vested on or before January 21, 1986, the greater of that number of months, or 36 months.
