

SUMMARY PLAN INFORMATION - 104(d) NOTICE  
FOR THE OHIO LOCAL NO. 1 OPERATIVE PLASTERERS' AND  
CEMENT MASONS' PENSION PLAN  
FOR THE 2023-2024 PLAN YEAR

To: Participating Employers of the Ohio Local No. 1 Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons' Pension Plan ("Plan")

The Ohio Local No. 1 Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons' Pension Plan (Employer Identification Number: 31-6126988; Plan Number: 001) is required to provide you the following information under Section 104(d) of the ERISA as amended by the Pension Protection Act of 2006(PPA). The following is a summary of the Plan during the 2023-2024 Plan Year, which began on May 1, 2023 and ended on April 30, 2024.

1. Contributions to the Plan are made monthly by employers pursuant to the terms of the collective bargaining agreements. The contribution rate varies by agreement.
2. There were 57 employers that reported and paid contributions to the Plan during the 2023-2024 Plan Year.
3. The following contributing employers paid 5% or more of the total contributions received by the Plan during the 2023-2024 Plan Year: George J. Igel & Co., Shelly & Sands/Kelly Paving, Complete General Construction, Bechtel Construction Corp, Newcomer Concrete Service, Baker Concrete Construction, and Kokosing Industrial.
4. No contributing employers withdrew from the Plan during the 2023-2024 Plan Year.
5. The Plan did not merge into or with any other plan during the 2023-2024 Plan Year.
6. For the 2023-2024 Plan Year, the Plan's monthly benefit credit was \$135 for a Year of Credited Service. The Plan also provides early retirement, disability, and pre-retirement death benefits.
7. There were no participants for whom no employer contributions were made during the 2022, 2023, or 2024 Plan Years due to employers who withdrew from the Plan.
8. For the 2023-2024 Plan Year the Plan was certified as not having a PPA funding status of Endangered, Seriously Endangered, Critical or Critical and Declining as defined by the PPA.
9. The Plan did not request an amortization extension or use the shortfall funding method during the 2023-2024 Plan Year.

Any contributing employer can receive a copy of the following items by making the request in writing: Form 5500, Annual Funding Notice, Summary Plan Description, and Summary of Material Modifications. In no case shall a recipient be entitled to receive more than one copy of any such document in a 12-month period and the Plan Administrator may charge a reasonable fee to cover the costs of copying and mailing the material.
