Paying claims and premiums for ineligible dependents increases our costs, reduces our benefits, and violates fiduciary rules imposed on the Board by Federal law. Therefore, we are conducting...

A health insurance dependent eligibility audit

The purpose of the dependent eligibility audit is to identify and remove dependent spouses and children who do not meet the health plan's eligibility rules for continuing coverage. This is a smart and proven way to help control healthcare costs.

To help us with this project, we have engaged an experienced, independent healthcare auditing firm, Amwins Group Benefits, to conduct the dependent eligibility audit for all employees with covered dependents on our healthcare plans. Here's how it will work...

The verification audit is an easy, two-step process

- First, the Online Affidavit. You will go to our dependent eligibility website (see the enclosed Quick Start Guide) and verify your current spouse and child relationships. This process takes just a few minutes. If you don't have Internet access, you can call the Eligibility Center at 1-866-691-6551 and provide your information to a Customer Care representative.
- Second, Verification Documents. You will submit official, legal documents that verify the statements you make online. When you finish your online affidavit, the website will tell you what documents to submit — and how to submit them. It's a convenient, easy process. **Please be sure to redact any SSN, account numbers and financial information from any documents you submit.**

The audit is mandatory with penalties for non-compliance

This audit requires **MANDATORY** participation by ALL employees with one or more covered dependents. If you do not complete the online affidavit and do not provide the requested documents for each of your dependents — OR if your responses are incomplete or inaccurate, then...your dependents could lose health insurance coverage under the Plan. Therefore, it's extremely important that you cooperate with this dependent eligibility audit.

Controlling healthcare costs is the shared responsibility of OCPCM AND every employee as well. Thank you for your cooperation in completing this verification quickly and accurately.
