

**AMENDMENT NO. 13  
TO THE  
RESTATED PLAN DOCUMENT  
OF THE  
EIGHTH DISTRICT ELECTRICAL PENSION FUND ANNUITY PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Restated Plan Document of the Eighth District Electrical Pension Fund Annuity Plan, revised and restated April 1, 2014, provides that the Plan may be amended by the Board of Trustees from time to time;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Trustees to amend the Plan Document;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following clarifications and amendments are made to the Plan Document:

**I. Section 9.05 shall be clarified by adding the following new Subsection (c):**

- c. If after designating a Spouse as a Beneficiary, the Employee or Participant is divorced or his marriage to such Spouse is annulled, the divorce or annulment revokes the designation unless, by virtue of a subsequent marriage, the Employee or Participant is married to such Spouse at the time of his death.

**II. Effective April 1, 2020, new Subsection (f) shall be added to Section 10.09 as follows:**

- f. Pursuant to IRS Notice 2020-23, any loan repayment due between April 1, 2020, and July 14, 2020, will be postponed upon request to July 15, 2020. Interest shall continue to accrue on postponed payments and, upon the end of the postponement period, future loan payment will be reamortized to account for increased limits. The term of such loan shall not be extended. If a Participant was delinquent as of March 31, 2020, the cure period otherwise ending on June 30, 2020 shall also be postponed upon request to July 15, 2020.

**III. Section 11.02 shall be amended by adding the following Subsection (d):**

- d. Effective March 1, 2020, pursuant to EBSA Disaster Relief Notice 2020-01, the following deadlines are postponed during the Outbreak Period:
  - 1. The five-year deadline set forth in Sections 6.04(c) and 7.04;
  - 2. The 60-day deadline to file an appeal upon an adverse benefit determination set forth in Section 11.02(a)(ii); and
  - 3. The 180-day deadline to file an appeal upon an adverse disability benefit determination pursuant to Section 11.02(b)(ii).


For purposes of this subsection (d), the "Outbreak Period" is defined as the period beginning March 1, 2020, and ending sixty (60) days after the end of the COVID-19 National Emergency declared by the President on March 13, 2020, or such other date announced by the Department of Labor in a future notice.

All other terms and conditions of the Plan shall remain in full force and effect.
