

**AMENDMENT SEVEN TO THE
RESTATED PLAN OF BENEFITS OF THE
OHIO CARPENTERS HEALTH PLAN**

WHEREAS, the undersigned represent the Board of Trustees (“Trustees”) of the Ohio Carpenters Health and Welfare Plan and Trust (“Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the Plan’s Trust Agreement empowers the Trustees to promulgate a Plan of Benefits and to amend the same from time to time;

WHEREAS, the Trustees now desire to restate the Plan’s provisions on Mental Health Care Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Trustees resolve to amend the Plan effective January 1, 2015, as follows:

Mental Health Services

Covered Medical Expenses

- Individual and group psychotherapy;
- Counseling with persons to assist with diagnosis and treatment. This coverage will provide payment for Covered Services only for those persons who are Eligible Persons under this Plan. Charges will be applied to the Eligible Person who is receiving family counseling services, not necessarily to the patient.
- Psychological testing;
- Electroshock therapy and related anesthesia;
- Services to determine if the mental disorder can be treated;
- Services necessary to evaluate or diagnose mental deficiency or retardation; and
- Services for the treatment of attention deficit disorder.

Your Physician or other Professional Provider must certify that there is a reasonable likelihood that your treatment will be of substantial benefit and that improvement is likely. The course of treatment your Physician or other covered Provider recommends must be acceptable to Medical Mutual. Inpatient care must be approved by Medical Mutual prior to admission.
